Hello HFH Staff,

Public Health will be on site tomorrow, Wednesday, February 10th to provide vaccines. Please read below for all the details:

Residents:

Many residents will receive their second dose and some will receive their first dose. The priority for the vaccines tomorrow will be the residents.

Everyone is working hard to ensure consent is complete, we have the supplies that are needed and we are prepared for the day. Thank you to everyone for your hard work.

Staff:

In addition, Public Health nurses will be able to provide staff with the vaccine.

We have been informed today that the Pfizer vaccine availability is very low. We do not know the amount of vaccine that Public Health will bring with them tomorrow.

Staff are eligible to receive the first dose of vaccine if you are working at Holy Family Hospital – LTC and are restricted to this single site.

Staff are eligible to receive their second dose of the vaccine if you received your first dose between December 15 – 31, 2020.

Please note the time for staff to receive the vaccine tomorrow:

When: **Wednesday, February 10th from 1-3pm**

Invited Essential Visitors:

Jasmine has invited our essential visitors to receive their vaccine. We have a list of essential visitors who are eligible.

Where: Entry from South Parking Lot by cafeteria

When: **Wednesday, February 10th from 1-3pm**

Important information:

- **Public Health has let us know that the vaccine supply is very low for staff. More VCH Clinics will be hosted if you cannot attend tomorrow.**
- You will be screened on arrival at the South Entrance Cafeteria door
- Please maintain physical distance outside if there is a line
- Please wear a mask
- Please do not come if you are experiencing any signs and symptoms of COVID-19
- Please bring your Personal Health Number (PHN)/Care Card number with you
- If you have received one dose already, please bring your yellow slip that was given to you when you received your first dose
- Washrooms on Level 1 are for emergency use only
- Essential visitors – the entrance on Level 1 supports wheelchair access
- Please allow for 15 minutes after receiving the vaccine to be observed by staff before leaving the building

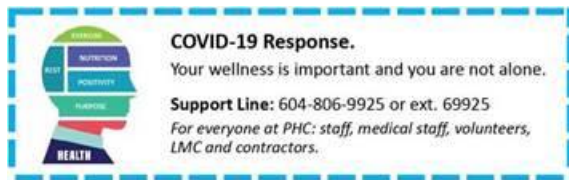
